- 1) We will get very messy here! Please dress your child(ren) in clothes that may be covered in paint, glue, mud, slime, food coloring, feathers, and a variety of other materials. I will not force your child to wear a smock, though they will be available. For Summer camp sessions, please send a bathing suit and towel for your child; again, these may get dirty. If your child is coming straight from school wearing a uniform, PLEASE pack a change of clothes.
- 2) We will have a snack together whenever a class or camp session lasts for two hours or longer. We will enjoy a variety of healthy snacks that are typically acceptable to young children. Fresh, filtered, cool drinking water will be available at all times. All allergies will be accommodated during snack time.
- 3) If your child is enrolled in a class that requires that you or a caregiver attend as well, please park on Summit Avenue or Valley Drive and walk up the driveway; never park on the driveway. If your child will be dropped off, please pull up to the driveway (not on to the driveway) on Summit Avenue and let your child out of the car on the CURB side of the car. Please stay until you're sure that I have seen your child and I've waved to you. Never drop your child off and drive away until you are sure s/he is safely in my purview.
- 4) Parents and caregivers are always welcome at ScienceArts. If your child is in a drop-off class, please join us...you'll be surprised at how much you might learn. You need not call or make an appointment to come into the classroom or outdoor space at ScienceArts. If your child is here, you're always welcome!
- 5) Please send your child with clothing for the outdoors no matter what the weather.
- 6) ScienceArts follows The City of Alexandria Public School system for weather-related closings. If the city's schools are closed, ScienceArts is closed. If the city's schools are opening one hour late, all ScienceArts classes will start on time. If the City's schools are opening two hours late, the morning classes at ScienceArts will be canceled. All afternoon classes at ScienceArts will start on time if the city's schools have a late start. No make-ups will be scheduled for classes that start late or are canceled due to weather.
- 7) If your child must miss a class due to vacation or illness, please contact me to so that we may try to schedule a make-up. Please be aware that there is no guarantee that a make-up class will be available.
- 8) For parent/caregiver-attended classes, we recognize that there are days when an older sibling is off from school and may need to attend as well. There will be a charge of \$20.00 per accompanying sibling. There will be a limit of two accompanying siblings per class, so please check with us in advance to be sure you may bring the older child along. No siblings or guests will be accommodated in drop-off classes.
- 9) A 50-percent non-refundable tuition deposit is due at the time of registration. All 50-percent balances are due in full by the first day of each session unless other arrangements are made. The return check fee is \$35.00.
- 10) We reserve the right to terminate enrollment for a child whose behavior is persistently inappropriate or unsafe. While 50 percent of each tuition amount is non-refundable, a refund will be made in these situations for remaining class time.
- 11) Participation in any ScienceArts program constitutes authorization for us to use photographs of children engaged in ScienceArts activities in its advertising and on its website.
